

What is a Story-telling Photo Quilt?

A photo quilt combines photographs with fabric to create a one-of-a-kind piece of art that can be used for warmth and comfort, as well as tell a story.

Using photographs and other items from your personal history, the images are transferred with a heat process onto fabric, and are then combined with fabrics to create a quilt.

Quilts can celebrate a special event such as the birth of a child, a wedding or anniversary, a birthday, or can commemorate the life of a lost loved one.

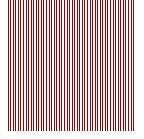

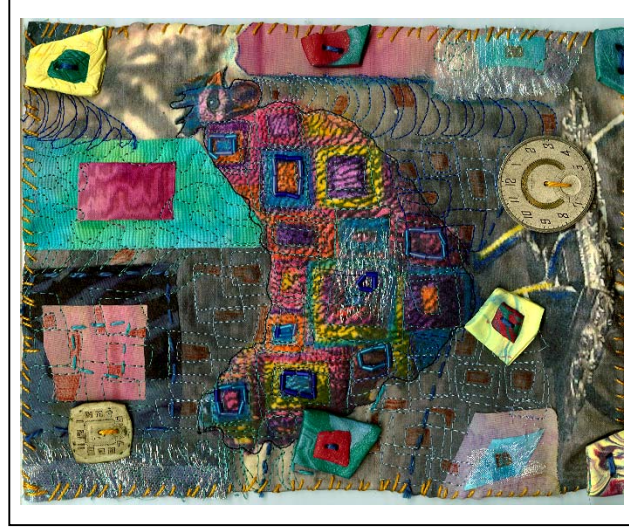


Memories In The Making!

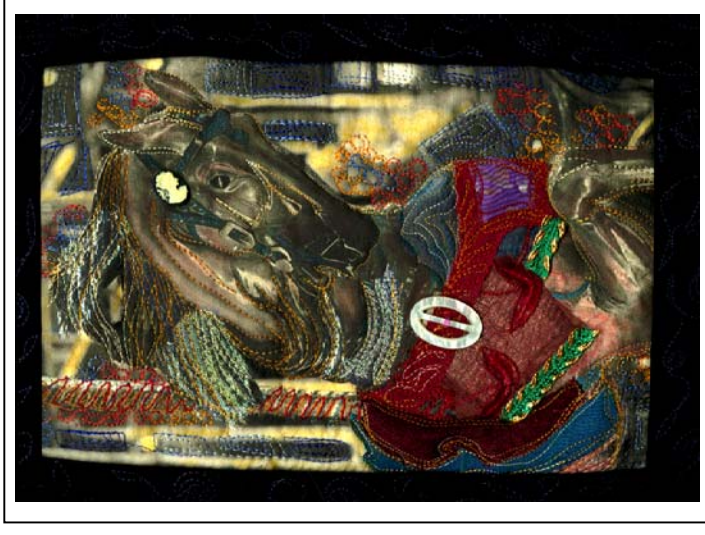
